HISTORY

To meet the uninterrupted educational requirements of Army Personnel who are posted in field areas and are frequently transferred, it was decided by Army Headquarter to open educational institutions named as Army Public Schools/Army Schools run on public lines in all the army cantonments of our country.

Army School, was raised on 01 April 1994 to meet the educational needs of the of Army Personnel residing in Gorakhpur as well as those posted in field areas outside Gorakhpur. The school is affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi under Affiliation No. 2180001. In 1995 with great zeal and effort of the Commandant GRD, Managing Committee and the Principal, the school was upgraded up to (+2) level with science stream. The school imparts high quality education and lays special stress on academic excellence and all round development of the child. In 1997, computer education was introduced as compulsory subject for all classes. In 1998, the school opened commerce stream at (+2) level and Information Practices was introduced as an optional subject at (+2) level. In 2004 school obtained affiliation in Computer Science and NCC for Junior boys was introduced. Army School shifted to a new premises in 2009 and has been named as Army Public School.

MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

The functioning of the School is managed by a very competent committee comprising of Senior Army Officers as well as intellectuals including educationist from various walks of life of Gorakhpur. The committee actively monitors all aspects of school functioning by regularly carrying out inspections/meetings.

AIM

- (a) To provide appropriate facilities for good schooling to the children of Army Personnel and other.
- (b) To impart high quality education to the children of all ranks without any discrimination by status.
- (c) To prepare the students for All India Secondary School Examination (X) and All India Senior Secondary School Examination (XII) of the Central Board of Secondary Education with a common syllabus for mid-session admission to the children of service personnel on transfer.
- (d) To promote development of academic excellence, discipline, personal character, high sense of values and national integration among the children.
- (e) To train and prepare students for competitive exams for higher education.

LOCATION

The school is located on NH-28 opposite AIIMS, Near Cantt. Railway Station, Gorakhpur.

SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE

The school building is spread over 11.5 acres of land. At the entrance of the School one sees eye catching statue of "Goddess Saraswati". The school has all the latest amenities including fully air-conditioned Conference Hall, Audio Visual Room, TAel, Science, AI, Atal Tinkering lab inclusive Room, Music room, SUPW room, Cafeteria, etc. In addition the school has large open playfields with state-of-art sports infrastructure. The school has also an updated Science Park, Open air gym for Primary children and well arranged Herbal Garden. There is an Activity shed and Parents Hut.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Army Public School, Gorakhpur is a co-educational school with medium of instruction being English. It is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi under affiliation No. 2180001


ADMISSION RULES

1. Admission to school is done through admission test. Priority is given to the children of Defence Service personnel.
2. “The priorities for admission subject to availability of seats will be as under :-
 - (a) Children of serving Army personnel including DSC (Ex-Army), Children of Army widows, children of those TA personnel who have a minimum of 5 years embodied service and children of serving NCC Whole Time Lady Officer (WTLO). MNS will be treated at per Army.
 - (b) Children of Ex-Army personnel retired/invalided out on medical grounds with pension, DSC personnel retired with pension from DSC and NCC Whole Time Lady Officer (WTLO) retired with pension.
 - (c) Children of serving Air Force, Naval and Coast Guard personnel.
 - (d) Children of retired Air Force, Naval and Coast Guard personnel.
 - (e) Children of Ex-Army personnel who left Army with less than 10 years of service and not categorized as ESM.
 - (f) Children of civilian paid out of Defence Estimates, Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF), Assam Rifles, MES, GREF, TA (when not embodied), NC (E) will be treated at par GREF.
 - (g) Grand Children of serving/retired Army personnel.
 - (h) Other children
3. Admission of children of Serving Army Personnel coming on transfer from station can be made at any time during the year.
4. Students coming from Army Public School on transfer will not appear for an admission test in the new



school if they have completed one academic session in the previous school and their academic record has been received with transfer certificate. Otherwise, they will also have to take an admission test in the new school and admission will be offered to them according to the decision of the Principal of the school.

5. Pupil seeking new admission as well as those coming on transfer from an Army Public School will have to produce a transfer certificate and progress card. In case that school is not an Army Public School, the certificate should be endorsed by the District Education Officer of the District in which the school is located. The endorsement should specifically indicate whether it is a recognised institution or not.
6. Admission of New Students of classes Nursery to IX in the school shall be made during the last week of March or 1st week of April.
7. Parents/Guardian will submit the application for registration for classes Nursery to IX on the prescribed form available in the office latest by 25th March.
8. Admission test will be conducted by the school on the dates to be notified by the Principal.
9. Admission will be allowed after a pupil qualifies in the test and submits the Transfer Certificate of the previous school along with the Progress Report of the last examination passed.
10. The standard of the admission test will be of the level of the annual examination of the class preceeding that to which admission is sought. The admission test will be held in the following subjects:
 - (a) Classes Nur to I - Teacher's interaction with the student.
 - (b) Classes II to V - English, Hindi, Mathematics and EVS
 - (c) Classes VI to VIII- English, Hindi, Maths and General Science
 - (d) Class IX-English, Hindi, Maths and Science.
 - (e) Class XI (PCM) – Physics, Chemistry, Maths and English
Class XI (PCB) – Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English
Class XI (Com.) – Maths and English
Class XI (Hum.) – History, Geography, English and Economics/Pol. Science
 - (f) Admission to class X and XII is not usually given except to the pupils coming on transfer and if there is any vacancy.



11. The Principal will arrange the Admission Test and his/her decision on admission will be final.
12. If in admission test for admission to a particular class, a pupil is found unsuitable for the class, then this shall not entitle the pupil for admission to the next lower class automatically without an admission test.
13. A pupil who fails once at the annual examination may be admitted to the same class in the next session of the same or of any other Army Public School. A pupil who fails twice at the annual examination shall not be admitted even in special cases.
14. The pupil should complete the age of 3 years on 31 st March of the year for admission to class Nursery but he/she should not be more than 5 years. The age for admission to other classes will be regulated accordingly.

Proof of Age

- (a) In case of Defence Personnel, extract of their record of service, duly attested by their Commanding Officers will be accepted as a conclusive proof for age of their children
 - (b) Birth certificates issued by Military/Civil Hospitals as well as Municipalities/Village Panchayats will also be accepted.
15. Admission To Class XI will be done as per existing Army Public School Rules, the grades for different streams for admission to class XI are given below.

1. Fee will be collected on quarterly basis between 05 to 15 of Apr, Jul, Sep and Jan through online mode.

2. Thereafter, late fine will be charged as under:-

(a) Upto 20th of the current month	100.00
(b) Upto 1 month	200.00
(c) Upto 2 months	400.00
(d) Upto 3 months	750.00

Upto three month means wef 01 to last date of 3rd month of quarter (Mar, Jun, Sep & Dec)	750.00

EXEMPTION CRITERIA

1. As per Army Headquarter's letter dated 17 August 1990 following concession have been announced for the children of war widow, battle casualties and permanently disabled during 1962,65, 71 wars, OP Pawan and OP Meghdoot.
(a) Complete exemption from tuition (full amount) and other fees levied by the educational institution concerned (including charges levied for the school bus maintained by the school).
(b) Cost of books
(c) Cost of uniform
2. The concession for books & uniforms will be recommended by the Principal in case of needy and deserving cases and decided by the Managing Committee.
3. An entitlement card will be issued to cases of above mentioned concessions.

PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fees will be collected quarterly w.e.f. 5th to 15th of April, July, October and January through online mode or in school by Debit/Credit card only.
2. If fee is not paid by 15th of above said months, late fee will be charged as under:

Upto 20 days means between 16 to 20 of first month of quarter (Jan. Apr. Jul and Oct)	100.00
Upto one month means w.e.f 21 to 30 of first month of quarter (Jan, Apr, Jul and Oct)	200.00
Upto two month means w.e.f 01 to last date of 2nd month of quarter (Feb, May, Aug & Nov)	400.00
Upto three month means w.e.f 01 to last date of 3rd month of quarter (Mar, Jun, Sep & Dec)	750.00
3. If fee is not paid for three consecutive months, the name of the student will be struck off the rolls.
4. In case there is any holiday on the fee collection days, the fee will be collected on the next working day.
5. Security Money is charged at the time of admission. The fine for any damage or loss, caused by any pupil, of the school articles like library books, laboratory equipment, furniture, etc. will be charged from his/her security money. The remaining amount will be returned when the pupil leaves the institution. For this they will have to produce the security money receipt. Hence the receipt must be kept safe.

Admission form has to be collected from school and following documents are to be submitted along with it:

- Application for admission
- Original TC
- Copy of Mark Sheet
- Copy of Student Aadhaar / Birth Certificate
- Original Serving Certificate/Copy of Discharge book
- Copy of Dependent ID card/ECHS Card
- Photograph

Note: Serving Certificate must contain Mother's name also.

Additional documents required for Direct Admission (admission after Board registrations) in class – 9th to 12th

- CTC (Certified True Copy) of Report Card of previous class.
- CTC of Transfer Certificate of previous school.
- Original List of Candidates (LOC) and a Certified True Copy (CTC)
- Copy of Transfer/Movement Order attested (in blue ink only) by the office where parent(s) of student joined after transfer.
- Local Residence Address as per office record to be issued by the Office where parent(s) of student joined after transfer.
- Processing Fee through DD.



SCHOOL CALENDAR

The calendar of the school broadly follows the following schedule:

- (a) The academic year is from April to March.
- (b) Summer vacation is for nearly 30-40 days during May and June.
- (c) Autumn break is of 10 days around Diwali festival.
- (d) Winter break is of about 10 days from 1 to 10 January.
- (e) Other holidays to be observed during the year are notified separately in School Diary.




